Milwaukie Bay Park Bank Repair

The City of Milwaukie is working with a design team to:

- Develop construction plans for stabilizing the bank
- Improve riparian habitat
- Provide a durable access route
- Enable park visitors to visit the low-water beach area safely

Use of Milwaukie Bay Park will be impacted through the end of November.

During construction, portions of the concrete path along the riverfront will be closed to the public. The low-water beach will be closed to public access for about 8 weeks while heavy equipment works in the area.









Kellogg Creek Bridge

In December 2015, record rainfall caused significant scouring and a bank failure near the footings of Kellogg Creek bridge. The City has elected to replace the bridge with help from a FEMA grant.

The new Kellogg Bridge is now open! The old bridge will be demolished in the upcoming weeks.

The new bridge features:

- Wider lanes
- Seismic preparedness

- ❖ A kayak rack
- Greater safety for pedestrians
- ❖ A sidewalk connecting south & north Milwaukie Bay Park
