Front Street is a part of downtown with a direct connection to the bay front, with pedestrian, bicycle and vehicle access to the downtown commercial core and visitor amenities, and proximity to Highway 101. Over time the area has changed and grown, but the community's vibrant waterfront Front Street vision remains. The project will build on the community's 2017 Front Street Action Plan work and Coos Bay 2020 Transportation System Plan.
